ABSTRACT:

The recent health emergency has had an undeniable impact on the lifestyle habits of families, in many aspects of daily life such as family relationships and work-life balance. Parents and children are now experiencing new challenges, mostly related to the establishment of new family dynamics. Greater sharing of domestic spaces between parents and children, extensive use of technological devices by adults and minors, which may favour forms of isolation and virtual experiences, overlapping of family and work values, difficulties in reconciling work and private life represent new critical issues of our families and will offer some important points for reflection and discussion, also from an emotional point of view.
